Petzl Technical Partner General Terms and Conditions

These Petzl Technical Partner General Terms and Conditions are established by the ZEDEL company, a French limited liability company with share capital of 2,400,000 euros, registered with the Grenoble, France company registry under registration number 411 851 926, and headquartered in the Crolles industrial zone in 38920 Crolles, France, also acting on behalf of other Petzl Group entities, hereinafter referred to as "Petzl".

The Petzl Technical Partner (hereinafter "Petzl-TP") shall:

1. Meet the requirements to be certified as a Petzl Technical Partner, as stated in "Petzl's requirements for Petzl Technical Partners".
2. Comply with all applicable legal requirements related to training activities, and bear all costs and expenses.
3. Agree that Petzl's published documents (including, but not limited to, training, support, processes, presentations, technical drawings, and any modifications or translations thereof) are the exclusive property of Petzl. Any representation, reproduction, modification, or translation, in whole or in part, or distribution in any form, without the prior written consent of Petzl is strictly prohibited.
4. Comply with the defined content, procedures and requirements for each Petzl Solutions Module. Any deviations from the Module must have prior written approval from Petzl. Indemnify and hold Petzl, all the other entities of the Petzl Group, and Petzl-TI harmless for any claims, actions for unapproved deviations or modifications to the content, procedures and requirements of a Petzl Solutions Module.
5. Indemnify and hold Petzl and all the entities of the Petzl Group harmless for any claims brought against Petzl and the Petzl Group for liability incurred, including payment of all reasonable attorneys' fees, costs or other expenses in defending against liability that arise

out of and/or are attributable to negligence, violation of applicable law, misrepresentations, unapproved deviations, translations, acts or omissions, or any other wrongful conduct by a trainee/trainer, relating to Petzl Solutions.

6. Use Petzl's trademarks for the limited purpose of identifying itself as an authorized Petzl Technical Partner. The Petzl-TP's use of Petzl's trademarks shall be strictly limited in accordance with the documentation provided by Petzl. The Petzl-TP is not authorized to adopt, use or register as a trademark, trade name, business name or corporate name, or part thereof, any word or symbol similar to Petzl's trademarks, trade name, business name or corporate name, nor use Petzl's trademarks on its corporate letters and documents, except as provided for by Petzl. The Petzl-TP shall take all measures necessary to avoid any use of the Petzl name which would create or maintain confusion in the public concerning the status of the Petzl-TP or its relationship with Petzl. The Petzl-TP shall not use Petzl's trademarks in its licensing activities or on any certificates or training content without the express consent of Petzl. The Petzl-TP shall immediately cease to use any training and assessment documents with reference to the Petzl trademarks upon termination or expiration of its status of Petzl-TP. The Petzl-TP specifically acknowledges and agrees that the use of Petzl's trademarks shall not create in the Petzl-TP any right, title, nor interest to Petzl's trademarks or any other intellectual property.
7. Maintain all records available for validation, including but not limited to: Petzl Solutions and Petzl Solutions Module(s); training database; trainer competencies; relevant insurance; and ongoing risk assessments.
8. Immediately inform Petzl and the other entities of the Petzl Group of any serious incident or accident, irrespective of whether any injury occurs, that arises from the use or training of any Petzl Solutions or Petzl Solutions Module.
9. Notify its Petzl-TI of any significant staff change or company restructuring.

10. Be available for validation by its Petzl-TI every three years or in the event of a change of its contact person.
11. Ensure that information and ideas flow between the Petzl-TP and Petzl-TI.
12. Be solely responsible for all information provided to third parties and bear all costs related to any complaints received.
13. Be solely responsible for any non-compliance with Petzl-defined procedures and requirements for Petzl-TPs and Petzl Solutions Modules.
14. Maintain records, including contact details of third parties (including without limitation, clients and trainees) to update them on Petzl Solutions updates.
15. Petzl and the other entities of the Petzl Group may, at any time after notifying the Petzl-TP, and at their own discretion, withdraw the title and certification of the Petzl-TP for any reason, including without limitation, non-compliance with these terms and conditions, or reasons related to safety and effectiveness. Upon receipt of such notice, the Petzl-TP shall immediately cease using the Petzl Technical Partner title and certification and any Petzl logo, trademarks, trade name, business name or corporate name related to this certification.

Corresponding Certificate:

This document remains valid as long as the Petzl Technical Partner maintains the requirements of a Petzl Technical Partner. The Petzl Technical Partner shall be visited at least every three years by its Petzl Technical Institute.
